

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Our Advantages

Academic Music Program

This program nurtures serious-minded young musicians and takes their musical knowledge and performing to the highest level. It is aimed at children with a passion for music, comprising of one-to-one instrumental tuition, group classes in musicianship (solfege, music theory, analysis, history of music and composition), and ensemble playing or singing, all scheduled after school hours. Students who attend this program are carefully assessed by internal exams and can also take the Associated Board of Royal Schools of Music exams (ABRSM) and the Sharqiyyat exam.

Music for All Program

Our Music for All Program is designed to spark a cultural movement among music enthusiasts of all ages. It consists of a wide variety of musical activities, which include one-to-one instrumental lessons and ensemble performing through playing or singing. The program is designed to help students enjoy singing or playing an instrument without the need to sit any internal or external exams. Our main aim is to inspire an appreciation of music in every part of the community.



Inspirational Teaching

Our teachers, many of whom balance teaching with successful performing careers in the music industry, teach over 450 individual instrumental lessons a week within both departments. Our students also have the opportunity to enjoy participating in a wide range of vocal and instrumental ensembles available to all levels of ability.

The three most prominent youth music ensembles in Qatar – Qatar Youth Orchestra, Qatar Youth Choir, and Master Takht (Arab Youth ensemble) – are also part of QMA.

We are the only music institution in Qatar that fully prepares students to continue their music studies at leading Music Universities and Conservatoires all around the world.

Outstanding Academic Records

Through a combination of the best music curricula, world-class teachers, and superb facilities, our students consistently achieve outstanding results in their music studies.

The ABRSM practical exam success rate has been continuously above 95%! Our students participate in numerous international music competitions and often come away winning their prospective categories.



Outreach Program

We have a very strong collaboration with Katara, Qatar Philharmonic Orchestra, Qatar Foundation Academies, Qatar University, and foreign embassies. Our students participate in numerous outreach programs throughout the year: from performing at Doha's schools, educational conferences, and graduation ceremonies to taking part in various music and art festivals.

In addition, we have signed an agreement with Conservatorio Della Svizzera Italiana in Lugano (Switzerland) to begin a long-term partnership. We hope this agreement will give our students and staff the opportunity to be involved in various collaborative music projects in the future.

QMA is also an associate member of the Association Européenne des Conservatoires (AEC), a European cultural and educational network with around 300 member institutions for professional music training in 57 countries. The AEC is the largest and most prestigious international organization of its kind, tasked with setting the standards for professional music education worldwide.



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Facilities and Campus

Thanks to the support of Qatar Foundation, we are able to offer our students state of the art facilities:

We continually invest in our equipment to make sure our students have the best resources possible to enhance their learning experience. With that in mind, we want our students to practice and perform on the best instruments available. We are the first music school in the Middle East to be credited as an 'All Steinways Piano School'.

The Academy is surrounded by shady mature trees and expansive lawns that lead to the cultural wonders of Katara, which include an alfresco amphitheater, an Opera House, and numerous cultural societies and institutions. We are truly at the crossroads of creativity and culture in Doha.

Twenty-nine oneto-one classrooms, six group classrooms, two performing spaces, a music library, a recording studio, and a music computer lab.
